Alban de Maily Nesle started his career in BNP Paribas in 1993 in the Corporate Banking Department then joined the Corporate Finance Department in 1996 where he took part in several mergers and acquisitions transactions in the financial institutional sector.

In 2000 Alban de Maily Nesle joined AXA as Head of Mergers & Acquisitions for Asia and the US. In 2007 he took the responsibility of the Group Corporate Finance Department, which encompasses Mergers & Acquisitions, Group finance and Treasury and Capital management activities.

In 2010, Alban de Maily Nesle became Chief Financial Officer of AXA MedLa region which covers Southern Europe countries, Latin America, African and Gulf countries.

In September 2013, Alban de Maily Nesle became AXA Group Chief Risk Officer where he has the responsibility for the Risk Management community area (100 people centrally and 550 people in local entities). It covers a broad range of topics including asset liability management, reserving process, product approval process, risk monitoring, operational risk, risk management systems, economic capital / internal model, etc.
