Lieutenant-colonel Axel CASTADOT is an expert of the Cybersecurity Operations Center of the French National Cybersecurity Agency (ANSSI). As a national authority, ANSSI ensures the security and defense of State information systems. Within this agency, Axel Castadot is Deputy Head of the Acknowledge and Anticipation Division of the Cybersecurity Operations Center, division in charge of threat intelligence, flaws, vulnerabilities and audits matters.

Officer in active duty, he is a graduate of signal officer academy (2000/2001) and ANSSI's cybersecurity expert training center (2012/2013).

Until 2012, he served as signal and IT platoon or compagnie commander, and he was deployed several times overseas. Then he joined the cybersecurity operations center of ANSSI, first to be in charge of the technical and operational liaisons and partnerships, and now in his current post to develop and share knowledge on threats and vulnerabilities.
