### **Historical Perspective and Prospective of Regulation in Insurance**

Insurance is a business particularly regulated. The first attempts of this control were set up already at the end of the 19th century, and public intervention has since regularly increased. Its forms have been deeply reformed, especially during the last quarter of the century. Above all, the regulator's role is intended to deeply evolve with the introduction of the new European directive of Solvency 2 and the creation of the French regulatory authority (ACP).
